Rebecca Lynsey continues to teach P6C due to Laura Dodds absence and Lynsey Clements PT will also teach there on Mondays and Tuesdays.


Nurture class cover was provided by Sarah Corrieri due to Shazia Hussnain being absent. She plans to return next week.




